

Each single mother family is provided a two bedroom and two bathroom apartment, including a kitchen and living room. The unit is fully furnished with everything needed to set up a household, including a washer and dryer. Mothers are provided mentoring, weekly case management, life skills classes (focused on parenting, finances and health and wellness), access to group and individual counseling, assistance with application to mainstream resources (Medicaid, SNAP, daycare vouchers, etc.), and assistance with enrollment into higher education. Families can stay as long as progress is made towards their established personal and career goals (typically two years). Mission Statement The New Beginnings is committed to providing a God-honoring resource to single mothers that assists them and their children both physically and spiritually in a way that demonstrates Christ's sacrificial love.

Although located in Cape Coral, Florida, any single mom in need across the nation is eligible to apply to the program. Our ministry seeks to help single mothers from any walk of life who want to change their lives for the better. We are here to provide these vulnerable families a safe haven along with critical supportive services that guide them towards healthy living and self-sufficiency.

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"This seems like a good time to share how grateful I am for being at **The** New Beginnings. When I came here, I was a different person – insecure, afraid, broken, depressed, hopeless. When I came to this country, I met and fell "in love" with a man, and four months later I was pregnant. I soon realized he was abusive, but I thought things would get better after the birth of our son. I was wrong... and things just got worse. I had started attending a church at that time, and one day a lady named Christie told me about The New Beginnings. I contacted TNB, and here I am two years later at The New Beginnings. I am not depressed, and my son is not observing the behavior of an abusive man. Instead, he is looking up to Godly men that surround us as mentors and church members, and he is learning healthy behaviors. I am no longer insecure and hopeless. God has removed all of my shame and has shown me that He loves me and wants me to know that I am worthwhile. The New Beginnings allows me to be a full-time student by day and a full-time mom when I come home. I am also proud to mention that I am in nursing school for an R.N. degree, and this would not be possible if I didn't have people around me here that believed in me and said I was capable. I am so thankful for the opportunity God gave me through Bill and Mary Masters, the founders of this program. I am learning that in all situations, good and bad, there is a lesson for us. Each time, instead of asking, "HOW can I get out of this trial?", I'm asking "WHAT can I get out of this trial?". I want to learn my lessons well! Thank you for taking the time to read my story."
